For Your Child

- ✓ Think before posting: *Who will see this? Is it safe?*
- ✓ Keep accounts and profiles **private**
- ✓ Use **strong, unique passwords** and never share them
- ✓ Avoid posting **live locations** or personal check-ins
- ✓ Come to you if unsure - no judgment for mistakes

For You as a Parent/Carer

- ✓ Review **your own privacy settings** regularly
- ✓ Ask before posting **photos or personal info** about your child
- ✓ Use **two-factor authentication** where possible
- ✓ Model safe online habits - children copy what they see
